Benchmarking Work Group – Meeting Notes

- 1) Tenant Authorization Issue - IOU advice filing
 - a) (SCE) Bob Levine: discussion with other Utilities. Let the commission know they are all on board, but approaches might be different. Some type of an advice letter of filing would be required (possibly modifying Rule 9) – not all IOUs would necessarily say the same things. Follow up scheduled for Thursday (5/14/09).
- 2) AB 1103 working group - We are working on the details of the requirements, hope to have them finished by late May / early June
- 3) Utility updates
 - a) SCE
 - i) Still NOT providing cost data – not required by AB 1103.
 - b) PG&E
 - i) If the PM user has manual entries, PG&E goes from last entry forwards, otherwise go from 2003 forward. Yogesh has fixed some of the individual accounts. A few more to still fix and update data back to Jan. 2003.
 - c) *Sempra – are you still on schedule for ABS 2.0 deployment May 15?*
 - d) *SMUD – any updates? Duplicate meter entry technical difficulties resolved?*
- 4) iv) Deauthorization in PM/ABS
 - a) Steve Miller (SRA) – PG&E and Sempra looking for more programmatic ways of informing Utilities about deauthorization than simply being denied access. Additional discussion planned.
- 5) Peter Flippen (ICF) – We would like to post your ABS cost study on the website.
 - a) Sempra wants to look at their cost estimation again, with new data, and soften the language so that it's clear the estimation is on the low side. Possibly ready by the next call (2 weeks).
