- 1) AB 1103 implementation regulations update
 - a) Some progress made, but not much over the last few months
 - i) Regulations currently at a stand still
 - (1) Resource issues at the CEC
 - (2) Conflicting interests: agreeing on the tenant confidentiality issue
 - b) Intent: implementation start date of Q1 2011 (but most likely not Jan. 1, 2011)
 - c) CPUC organized meeting with CEC, IOUs, EPA
 - i) Goal: come to consensus on resolution for confidentiality issue
 - ii) Possibility of using aggregate data with a virtual meter
 - 2) IOU statewide benchmarking implementation group
 - a) PG&E waiting for clarification from CPUC
 - b) SCE conducting trainings on benefits of benchmarking
 - i) Internally & to customers
 - ii) Many are joint sessions with SoCalGas
 - iii) Receive about 100 customers a month sign up in PM as a result
 - 3) ABS status
 - a) SCE still working on automated system – will be ready by AB 1103 start date
 - i) Experienced unforeseen roadblocks

- ii) Continue to bring IT staff up to speed
- iii) Current status:
 - (1) Selected SCE as ESP: 88 customers, 820 buildings, 1,500 meters
 - (2) Receiving data from SCE: 70 customers, 767 buildings, 1,305 meters
- b) Outage of ABS test environment (not live environment) Sunday, October 3
- c) Inactive accounts – way to delete from PM system?
 - i) No general procedure for account or building cleanup based on dormancy
 - ii) If list of inactive accounts sent to PM, can be deleted
